Family Counseling

Regular Programs

Provides 6 to 10 sessions free counseling, Consultations are also available at night and on weekends!

• Couples counseling

We are conducting marital consultation so that couples undergoing conflicts can restore their relationship and maintain a good family bonding. You can get advice on a variety of topics that can occur between couples such as problems of personality, values, religion, stress, and sexuality, etc.

• Parent-child counseling

Various problems that can occur between parent and child, such as disconnection of parent-child relationship, child's parent rejection, child's personality/ values problem, runaway home, career / employment problem, delinquency problem, suicide problem, child-friend relationship and social maladjustment and to help them recover their relationship.

• Family counseling

We offer counseling such as couple counseling, parent-child counseling and consult about problems between families. You can get advice on relevant issues on how to cope with family issues and adaptability, and emotional relationships with your family.

• Multicultural Family Counseling

Multicultural family counseling aims to help the difficulties of multicultural families, not only in psychological problem for individual marriage immigrants, but also an overall counseling service to help the family members. We will help solve the problems faced by the multicultural family and the family life cycle, and help you build a healthy family relationship.

• Before and after divorce counseling

Psychological stability, emotional problems, economic problems, child rearing and consensus of couples who are considering divorce or appealing for adjustment after divorce and helps rational decision-making and supports relationship adjustment through counseling.

• Legal counseling

Legal issues related to your family, such as divorce, inheritance, and debt, will be handled once a month (second Tuesday) by consultation with a lawyer. Night and weekend consultations will proceed!

Strengthening family competence support project

Helps families with difficulties in the home (low income, single parents, unwed parents, North Korean defectors, multicultural families) solve problems and strengthen their functions as an emergency crisis family member facing domestic violence, divorce, and crisis cases.
