Family Counseling

We offer counseling such as couple counseling, parent-child counseling and consult about problems between families. You can get advice on relevant issues on how to cope with family issues and adaptability, and emotional relationships with your family.

- Provides 10 consultations when 2 or more people participate in 3 or more sessions (Seoul City Family Counseling Support Project)
- Provides 6 consultations when a person participated once.
- Face-to-face/non-contact/video/telephone counseling is available.

Marriage checkup

- Building a healthy marital relationship through regular marital check-ups.
- The marital relationship is checked through an objective measuring tool.

Strengthening family capabilities & Case management

It helps families with difficulties in the home (low-income, single-parent, single mother and father, North Korean refugees, multicultural families), emergency crisis families facing family violence, divorce, crisis, etc. Families with difficulties, please feel free to contact us.

Child care support project

In-charge: Park, Hyejeong (Extension 801)

We provide childcare services to children aged 3 months or older and 12 years of age or younger in families with a parenting gap due to reasons such as double-income to reduce the burden of parenting.

Bilingual Environment Creation Program

In-charge : Choo, Heeyeon, Hirokko (Ext. 401, 402)

By creating an environment where multicultural children can naturally communicate in bilingual languages from infancy. We provide support to establish a healthy identity for children and grow up into global talents.

Marriage immigrant's Translation and interpretation service

In charge: Cha, So-hyeon (Extension 507)

Marriage immigrants face various communication problems in Korean society. To this end, we provide various interpretation and translation services for family and social life. Interpretations such as family communication and emergency assistance in crisis situations are possible, so please feel free to contact us.

Korean language education to support marriage immigrants' competency reinforcement

In-charge : Kim, Yewon (Ext. 405)

We provide a variety of customized real-life Korean language education such as TOPIK class, child study guidance, job Korean language, speaking, and grammar classes for marriage immigrants and immigrated children to resolve communication difficulties and support smooth adaptation to life in Korea.

Language development support service

In-charge : Jeong, Daeun, Seoul, Mun-gyeong (Ext.505, 506)

Evaluate the level of language development of children of multicultural families and provide customized language education to children who have difficulty communicating to allow a good language development. We also provide counseling and give education on teaching methods for multicultural parents to help promote children's language development in their everyday life
